Avon Property and Business Owner,

The 30th annual ***Centura Health & NexCore's Salute to the USA presented by Westin Riverfront Resort & Spa*** takes place in Avon on Sunday, July 3rd, starting at 5:00 p.m., and ending at approximately 10:30 p.m.

The Town of Avon is thrilled to once again be launching the greatest fireworks display in the State and providing the community with live performance art, great food, ice cold beer, sumptuous wine and a beautiful park to enjoy with family and friends. The Independence Holiday brings many visitors to our community who will be dining and shopping in Avon over the long weekend. The event is expected to host approximately 19,000 guests.

Avon Transit Modifications

- Avon Blue Line buses will not service the Lake Street and the Comfort Inn stop starting Sunday, July 3rd at 6:00 a.m. to 10:30 p.m.; passengers should use the Sheraton Mountain Vista bus stop.
- All other Avon Transit bus stops will operate as normally scheduled.

Fencing in Nottingham Park

- Chain link fencing will be installed in Nottingham Park on Thursday, June 30th and be removed on Tuesday, July 5th. Portions of the recreational path around the lake will not be accessible during this time.

Nottingham Park & Lake Closures

- For safety purposes, portions of Nottingham Lake will be closed starting at 8:00 a.m. on July 2nd through July 3rd at 4:00 p.m. Nottingham Lake in its entirety will close at 4:00 p.m. until 11:00 p.m.; all lake activities will cease at 2:50 p.m. on July 3rd.
- Portions of Nottingham Park will be closed on July 3rd between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. for event set-up.
- During the partial closure mentioned above, guests will be allowed to access the North side of the park via the parking lot located on W. Beaver Creek Blvd., the recreational path on the west end of the Park and the Lake Street north terminus entrance. Guests should be prepared to have coolers, back packs, picnic baskets, etc. checked prior to entry.
- During the partial closure, guests will not be allowed access to the main athletic field, Performance Pavilion and picnic shelter until all gates open at 5:00 p.m.

Temporary Road Closures

- Lake Street will be closed at W. Beaver Creek Blvd. to Benchmark Road (Avon Town Hall) starting at 7:00 a.m. Sunday, July 3rd, ending at 11:00 p.m.
- Mikaela Way will be closed starting at 7:00 a.m. until 11:00 p.m. Sunday, July 3rd.
- Riverfront Lane will be closed starting at 7:00 a.m. until 11:00 p.m. Sunday, July 3rd
- Additional road closures will be necessary during egress only between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. on Sunday, July 3rd.

Temporary Building Closures

- Avon Recreation Center (ARC) will be closed Sunday, July 3rd, and will re-open at 8:00 a.m. on Monday, July 4th.

Temporary Parking Lot Closures

- ARC west and north parking lots will be closed starting at 6:00 a.m. Sunday, July 3rd until 11:00 p.m. They will be open for permit parking only between 5:00 p.m. and 10:30 p.m. on July 3rd.
- Town Hall parking lot on the east and west side of the building will be closed starting at 9:00 p.m. Saturday, July 2nd until Sunday, July 3rd at 11:00 p.m. Permit parking only will be allowed.
- Avon Elementary School parking lot and lower athletic field will be closed starting at 7:30 a.m. on Thursday, June 30th through Sunday, July 3rd at 11:00 p.m.

Before your family celebrates, make sure everyone knows how to do so safely. For all emergencies, please dial 911.

ERFPD would like to remind residents and visitors that Colorado Law prohibits the general public from using any type of fireworks that leaves the ground (i.e., professional grade fireworks). Consumer grade fireworks are legal, including sparklers and firecrackers; however, these items burn at extremely high temperatures (in some cases at more than 1,800° F). If not handled properly, fireworks can cause burn and eye injuries in kids and adults. As an alternative to personal fireworks, the Eagle River Fire Protection District encourages the public to enjoy the wonderful firework displays conducted by trained professionals during the Town of Avon's FirstBank Salute to the USA and other local Fourth of July celebrations.

If you are planning on camping, please be aware that fire restrictions could be enacted at any time. Check with your local fire district or law enforcement agency for current fire conditions and restrictions.
